Sub: Promotion of an Eco-Friendly Diwali in Uttarakhand - reg.

Sir,

As Diwali approaches, the Uttarakhand Pollution Control Board (UKPCB) is actively promoting a sustainable, eco-friendly celebration to address the environmental impact of traditional festivities. Diwali, a cherished time of joy and togetherness, has traditionally been associated with elevated pollution levels due to the widespread use of conventional fireworks. In recent years, these effects have had an increasingly impact on the air quality, public health, and environment in Uttarakhand. Therefore, an emphasis on reducing firecracker use and promoting green alternatives is essential to mitigate these effects.


The Uttarakhand Pollution Control Board conducts a 15-day monitoring program (7 days before Diwali, on Diwali, and 7 days after) to assess the impact of firecrackers on air quality and noise levels. Observations indicate that the Air Quality Index (AQI), which is generally "moderate" before Diwali, often spikes to "very poor" during the festival, affecting respiratory health. Noise levels across various cities in Uttarakhand have shown a steady increase during Diwali, often surpassing ambient noise standards and posing risks to hearing health. The widespread use of firecrackers not only disrupts human environments but also has adverse effects on wildlife, especially near national parks, where the loud sounds can distress animals and disturb local fauna. Promoting noise-reducing practices and raising awareness of these impacts are crucial steps toward a more harmonious celebration. Firecrackers producing noise levels above 125 dB at a distance of 4 meters from the point of burst are prohibited. Additionally, firecrackers may only be set off between 8:00 PM and 10:00 PM on Diwali.

To mitigate these effects, UKPCB has taken measure to control AQI during Diwali to spike from Moderate to Poor or very poor level and increase in noise pollution for which board is taking following measure:

- **Dust Control:** Sprinkler machines and drones in high-pollution areas.
- **Public Awareness:** Billboards, standees, and newspaper ads promoting eco-friendly practices.
- **Mobile Campaigns:** Spreading messages on pollution control.
- **Broadcast Messages:** Promoting clean Diwali practices via waste collection vehicles.
- **Waste Management Drives:** Preventing open burning and reducing fire risks.

In view of above, it is requested to kindly to join us in these efforts encouraged the use of green crackers, eco-friendly celebrations by disseminating information on eco-friendly practices and supporting our measures to ensure cleaner, safer festivities. Together, we can make a significant impact in reducing pollution and preserving Uttarakhand's environment.
