- 1 Contract period shall be **Six years** for Assignment “A”, “B” & “C” from the date of Letter of Award (LoA) & may vary as per scope of work/ timelines changed.
- 2 The EMD can be submitted in the form of Bank Demand Draft/FDR/CDR in favour of MD, Power Transmission Corporation of Uttarakhand Ltd. payable at Dehradun from any Scheduled Bank /nationalized Bank. Alternatively it can be furnished in the form of Bank Guarantee as per Performa given in RFP document.
- 3 The prospective bidders are advised to obtain their user ID, Password, Company ID from website www.uktenders.gov.in for registration on the e-tender website.
- 4 The bidder can freely view and download the e-tender document from the website www.uktenders.gov.in and submit the bid on or before the date as mentioned in column No. 6 of above table. The tender fee shall be as mentioned in column 5 in the shape of DEMAND DRAFT of any scheduled bank payable at Dehradun in favour of “**MD, Power Transmission Corporation of Uttarakhand Ltd.**” which must reach in original hard copy in the Office of **Superintending Engineer (C&P-II), PTCUL, Vidyut Bhawan, Near ISBT crossing, Majra, Saharanpur Road, Dehradun** along with original hard copy of EMD, Schedule-C (bid validity declaration) (as per format provided in PQR sheet), certificate (as per format provided in PQR sheet) and Affidavit in support of submission of documents (as per format provided in PQR sheet) in separate envelope on or before the closing date & time of submission of bid. The scanned copy of tender fee, EMD, schedule-C, certificate and Affidavit in support of submission of documents shall also be uploaded on e-tender website at the prescribed place.
- 5 **The bidder has to quote their prices in ‘price bid format/BOQ in excel sheet’ only as given on e-tender website. The price bid in PDF is strictly not to be submitted/uploaded.** The ‘PQR sheet’ is given in excel format. The bidder shall fill the same and upload with the bid in pdf format on e tender website.

All the tender documents will be carried out only through E-tendering mode and the bidder has to submit all his tender documents (Like PQR Sheet, Price Bid, pre-qualifying documents/Supporting Documents, scanned copy of Tender fees, EMD, Schedule-C etc.) on the e-tendering website www.uktenders.gov.in.

The bidders shall also submit the hard copy of all the pre-qualifying documents/Supporting Documents (**at least Two set duly stamped, signed & page numbered**), original hard copy of tender fees, EMD, schedule-C, certificate and Affidavit in support of submission of documents to this office up to the closing date and time of the submission of bid.

- 6 **It is mandatory for the bidders to submit the original tender fee in the form of DD (Non refundable), original hard copy of the EMD, schedule “C”, certificate (as per format provided in PQR sheet) and Affidavit in support of submission of documents (as per format provided in PQR sheet) (all should be in a single separate envelope) at the office of Superintending Engineer (C&P-II), PTCUL, Vidyut Bhawan, Near ISBT crossing, Majra, Saharanpur Road, Dehradun on or before closing date & time of submission of bid, failing which the bid shall be rejected as per provisions of the RFP document.**

1.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Qualifying Requirement (QR) for consultants (Financial and Technical):

The bid invitation is open to the firms /organization /consultants who meet the qualification requirements stipulated below:

The bidder shall provide satisfactory evidence of:

- 1.1 The bidder /firm must have successfully completed similar assignment as defined in the scope of work in any CPSU/SPSU/Public/Private (Transmission/Generation/Discom Company) during last seven years.
- 1.2 The bidder /firm should have experience in handling at least five assignments involving regulatory assistance/Tariff petition filing/MYT support to power utilities/CTU/State's Electricity Regulators/JERC/Central electricity regulator in India over the seven years out of which at least three assignments should be involving transmission utilities (CTU/STU).
- 1.3 The bidder /firm should have successfully completed similar assignments as mentioned in Sr. No. 1.1 (above) during last seven financial years ending on 31.03.2024
 - a) Three similar completed works costing not cost less than the amount equal to Rs. 6758253.00 or
 - b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 8447817.00 or
 - c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to Rs. 13516506.00
- 1.4 The bidder/firm must enclose certificate from principal employer towards satisfactory completion of such assignments as specified at Sr. No. 1.3 (above) failing which the bid would not qualify.
- 1.5 The bidder /firm must provide details of its professionally qualified personnel, having proficiency in rendering consultancy work of similar type with names of organization where such services have been rendered. PTCUL reserves the right to verify such statements.
- 1.6 The bidder must have average annual turnover of at least Rs. 4223908.00 out of consultancy work, during the last best three financial years out of the last five years ending on 31.3.2023 or 31.03.2024.

Note: The balance sheet and all other financial documents attested/certified by CAs to substantiate fulfillment of FQR should be with UDIN failing which the tender will be summarily rejected without any further reference.

2.0 E.P.F. Registration certificate is mandatory to be submitted with the technical bid (part-I).
