1. The prospective bidders are advised to register with Uttarakhand Government E-Tender Portal www.uktenders.gov.in in advance and obtain their user ID, password, company ID etc. and complete all other statutory requirement for participation in e-tendering.
2. The bidder can freely view and also download the e-tender documents from the website www.uktenders.gov.in and also submit the bids on or before the dates as mentioned in column nos. 7 of above table. However for participation in the tender, the bidder shall have to upload the details of DD (tender fee as mentioned above) at the time of request of tender. The tender fee, as mentioned above, shall be paid in shape of Demand Draft of any Scheduled/Nationalized Bank only and shall be in favour of the **Executive Engineer, Test & Commissioning Division, Dehradun, Payable at Dehradun** of any scheduled Bank payable at **Dehradun**. The tender fee shall be submitted in original with other tender documents, which must reach Office of **Executive Engineer, Test & Commissioning Division, 132 kV S/s Majra Dehradun-248001** along with EMD and Schedule-C in separate envelope on or before the closing date & time of submission & opening of Part-I (Technical Bid). The scanned copy of tender fee shall also be uploaded on e-tender website at the prescribed place. **Tender fee is non-refundable.**
3. The EMD can be submitted in the form of bank DD/BG/FDR/CDR of any Scheduled Bank /Nationalized Bank only and shall be pledged in favour of **Executive Engineer, Test & Commissioning Division, Dehradun, Payable at Dehradun** of any scheduled Bank payable at **Dehradun**. The EMD shall be submitted in original with other tender documents, which must reach Office of **Executive Engineer, Test & Commissioning Division, 132 kV S/s Majra Dehradun-248001** along with Tender Fee and Schedule-C in separate envelope on or before the closing date & time of submission & opening of Part-I (Technical Bid). The scanned copy of EMD shall also be uploaded on e-tender website at the prescribed place.
4. The bidder has to quote their prices in **'price bid format/BOQ in excel sheet'** only as given on e-tender website. **The price bid in PDF is strictly not to be submitted/uploaded.**
5. The bidder also to upload the duly filled 'PQR sheet in PDF format' on e-tender website.
6. All the tender documents will be carried out only through e-tendering mode and the bidder has to submit all his tender documents (Like PQR Excel Sheet and Price Bid) in the e-tendering website www.uktenders.gov.in and in the meantime the bidders have to scan their Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), and all the pre-qualifying documents/Supporting Documents for uploading and also submit the hard copy of the same to the undersigned office within the last date and time of the submission of tender.
7. This office shall not be responsible if the tender fee, EMD and Schedule-C is delayed in transit or is not made available by the Postal Department/Courier at the prescribed address above.

8. It is mandatory for the bidder to submit the tender fee in the form of DD(Non Refundable), original hard copy of EMD, schedule C, hard copy of all other prequalifying documents/ supporting documents/certificates of tender document to the Office of Executive Engineer, Test & Commissioning Division, 132 kV S/s Majra Dehradun-248001, on or before due date.
9. E-tenders will be received and opened on the date as mentioned above or any extension thereof. In case the above date is declared a holiday, the tenders will be received & opened on the next working day.
10. It is mandatory for the bidder to submit Schedule-C (Bid validity declaration of 6 Months) and 'Declaration' regarding correctness of the documents & The Service provider should not have been black listed as on the last date of proposal, in Rs.100 stamp duly notarized as per the format given in the PQR excel sheet of the tender documents and also upload the copy of the same on e-tender website with the supporting document of technical bid proposal.
11. The bidder are requested to read all the instructions/conditions of the bid documents & NIT carefully and submit their bid accordingly . Be insured that all the required and supporting documents has to be uploaded on e-tender website.
12. The Part-II of the tender, belonging to only those tenderers who qualify for the work on the basis of PQR /FQR /TQR and the documents provided by them in Part-I, shall be opened .The undersigned reserves the right to reject the offer of one or all the tenderers and award the work by dividing it among two or more tenderers without assigning any reason thereof. All other terms and conditions shall be as per tender documents.
13. The tenders should be submitted in the Proforma prescribed and bids received without attachment with e- tender, the tender documents shall not be considered.
14. If the tenderer withdraw their offer within the validity period, the earnest money deposited by them shall be forfeited to PTCUL similarly if the tenderer made any alteration/modification in tender after its opening, the tenders will be rejected and the earnest money deposited shall be forfeited.
15. As per guidelines/circular dated 31.08.2011 and dated 18.04.2010 by Directorate STQC, IT Department, New Delhi and CVC, Govt. of India, the use of **Class-3 Digital Signature**, procured from any certifying authority, is made mandatory for the contractors/firms to login on the website www.uktenders.gov.in. Part B

Technical Qualifying requirement:-

1. . The Bidder must be Experienced Contractors/Authorize Dealer/Firm/Manufacturer .
2. **Guaranteed Technical Particulars:** The Work/Equipment/Materials shall meet the minimum guaranteed Technical Particulars specified in this tender.
3. **Supply/Work Experience:** The Bidder must have adequate experience and satisfactory past performance on similar nature of supply/works in any State/Central/ or any CPSU/PSU or any Transmission Licensee awarded with Transmission Project in India during last 07(seven) years. Photostat copies of order and performance report of similar nature of supply/works from various Government Departments also be given. Submission of work completion certificate, clearly indicating the work completion date and executed amount of work, is mandatory for supporting the claim of work experience.
4. If in any case two or more bidder quotes the lowest rate for the same work, the work will be divided equally among the bidders those offering the equal quotes/rates. The right of equal division/allotment of work will be wholly reserved with the authority of calling the tender. After participation in tender if the lowest bidder disagree with the above clause the EMD so deposited with the bid will be forfeited by the concerning authority.
5. In addition, the Qualifying Requirements if any, in the 'Special Conditions of Contracts' shall also be applicable.
6. The Tenderer must have experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:
 - (a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to **Rs. 3.50 Lakhs (40% of Tender Value)**.
OR
 - (b) Two Similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to **Rs.4.10 Lakhs (50% of Tender Value)**.
OR
 - (c) One similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to **Rs. 6.50 Lakhs (80% of Tender Value)**.
7. In the above criteria, the "Similar Work" shall be "**Supply and installation of electrical equipments and Civil works**".

8. The Tenderers should furnish the details of their experience, competency and statement of past/current works and supplies to this tender in form annexed. Photostat copies of order and performance reports of these items from various State Electricity Boards/other Govt. Departments also be given.
9. Documents related to work experience in PTCUL, must be signed by officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer.
10. 'A' class electrical contractor's registration copy with validation issued by the appropriate electrical safety department .
11. The above cited requirements are only indicative. The owner reserves the right to requisition any other relevant information and also reserves the right to reject the Bid proposal of any Bidder, if in the Owner's opinion the Qualification data is incomplete and Bidder is not qualified to perform the Contract satisfactorily.

FQR (Financial Qualification Requirement)

The Balance sheet and other financial documents attested/ certified by CAs to substantiate fulfilment of FQR should be with UDIN failing which the tender will be summarily rejected without any further reference.
